She is a coordinator of Warrnambool's Multicultural Women's Circle and has developed a comprehensive migrant settlement resource booklet now in its 3rd edition. Wei-Lin has recently been appointed as the member for the Victorian Multicultural Commission's Regional Advisory Council for the Barwon South West region, and advocates for residents from the CALD backgrounds.
