During a career of 27 years in Local Government working as an Environmental Health Officer, Bob Handby took leave to work with the International Committee of the Red Cross to some of the world's worst humanitarian disasters. These disasters include conflict zones in Uganda, Iraq, Rwanda, Kosovo and Sri Lanka. He has also worked on significant natural disasters like the Boxing Day Tsunami in Banda Aceh, Cyclone Nargis in Myanmar and floods in Pakistan.

Bob has also worked in disaster throughout Australia including bush fires, floods and cyclones. Bob is an Honorary Life Member of Australian Red Cross and in 2018 was awarded an Order of Australia. You will be intrigued by his stories of working in the field as an aid worker.
